Day 01: Say Bonjour to your dream trip! Arrive in Paris and Orientation tour.

Today we start our day with a visit to the Palace of Versailles. Constructed primarily in the 17th century, this magnificent Royal Palace was home to Marie Antoinette and Louis XIV (the Sun King). The Palace of Versailles is historically significant as the location where the Treaty of Versailles was signed in 1919, officially ending World War I. The guided tour includes visiting the Grand Apartment, the Chapel, and the Hall of Mirrors. Later we proceed for a city tour of Paris: Feel the zest of the city with an exhilarating city tour that includes the best-loved Parisian sights – Arc de Triumph, Champs Elysees, Concorde Square, Opera House, Napoléon's Les Invalids, Alexander Bridge, and many more sights. Later we proceed to ascend the Eiffel Tower (3rd Level) to appreciate the spectacular view of Paris in all her glory. Built in 1889 for the World Fair, the Eiffel tower is now a symbol of the city and one of the most recognized buildings in the world.

In the evening enhance your Paris sightseeing experience on a romantic Sightseeing Cruise on the River Seine. Feel the love in the air as you drift along the river on this romantic cruise and see the Cathedral of Notre Dame, Ile de la Cite, beautiful bridges, historical monuments, and many more Parisian Sights. Enjoy the specially planned Paris by Night Tour with Lamp-lit bridges, a sparkling Eiffel Tower, & many more sights. This evening we'll fall in love with everything Paris on this dreamy night-time tour.

Day 03: Orientation tour of Brussels, the capital of the European Union. Visit to Mini Europe. Visit to the Atomium.

Checkout and proceed to Brussels, capital city of Belgium and Headquarter of the European Union. On arrival proceed for an Orientation tour of Brussels. During the tour group will visit one of Europe's most beautiful square the Grand Place, which is home to the medieval Town Hall, See Guild houses, Maison di roi means the Kings House. A great opportunity to click a photo at the fabled Manneken Pis statue depicting a urinating little boy which is probably Brussels' most famous landmark. You will have Free time for shopping for chocolate, beer, fries and waffles.

Visit Mini Europe a miniature park which features reproductions of famous landmarks and buildings from European countries at a scale of 1:25. Mini-Europe offers a unique and entertaining way for visitors to explore the architectural wonders of Europe in a condensed space, making it a popular attraction for those interested in history, culture, and travel.

Later we visit the Atomium, which is the iconic symbol of Brussels and a popular tourist attraction, drawing visitors from around the world to explore its unique architecture. The Atomium, built for the 1958 World Fair, symbolizes an iron crystal, magnified 165 billion times consisting of nine interconnected spheres. Each sphere has a diameter of 18 meters. The top sphere, accessible by an elevator, features an observation deck that offers panoramic views of the city. Visitors can enjoy a 360-degree view of Brussels and its surroundings. Get a taste of modern Brussels at the Atomium.

Day 04: Beautiful day is planned in The Netherlands with Visit to Keukenhof Garden (until 12th May 2024). Visit to picture sque town of Volendam (from 13th May 2024). Orientation tour of Amsterdam by Canal cruise. Visit to Wooden Shoe & Cheese farm. Free time at Dam Square.

Today you will have fascinating tour in The Netherlands, famous for its fine culture, rich history and beautiful canals. After a breakfast in the hotel the group will proceed to the south of the city of Lisse to tour the Keukenhof Gardens (until 12th May 2024) where vast numbers of tulips, daffodils, and hyacinths create dazzling patches of colour. The park is said to be the greatest flower show on earth, and it's Holland's annual spring gift to the world or drive to Volendam (from 13th May 2024)a picturesque town in North Holland, known for its traditional Dutch architecture, fishing boats, and vibrant atmosphere. Volendam is a charming destination that provides a glimpse into traditional Dutch life and culture. Later we will proceed for an orientation tour of the city of Amsterdam by Canal cruise. This is a popular and delightful way to explore the picturesque city of Amsterdam. We then visit the Clog and Cheese making factory. Witness a demonstration of how cheese is made. You also have a chance to savour some authentic Dutch cheese. Watch a shoemaker make clogs and wooden shoes carved out of wooden blocks. Spend some free time at Dam Square.

Overnight in Belgium/The Netherlands Meal: Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

Day 05: City tour of Luxembourg. Orientation tour of Strasbourg.

Today morning after the breakfast, we check out and proceed to Luxembourg. a landlocked country famed for its Roman heritage and architectural beauty. Luxembourg's blend of history, natural beauty, and economic significance makes it a unique and dynamic destination. Embark on a comprehensive sightseeing tour of the city, visiting alluring landmarks like the Royal Palace of the Grand Duke, the 17thcentury Notre-Dame Cathedral and many more sights. We will have an opportunity to take a photo at The Monument of Remembrance, usually known by the nickname of the Gëlle Fra (Golden Lady). Later we will continue our journey towards Strasbourg. It's the formal seat of the European Parliament and sits near the German border, with culture and architecture blending German and French influences. Strasbourg is often referred to as the "Capital of Christmas." The Strasbourg Christmas market, known locally as "Christkindelsmärik," is one of the oldest and most famous Christmas markets in Europe. The magnificent Notre dame de Strasbourg Cathedral serves as a stunning backdrop to the Christmas market. The cathedral is beautifully illuminated, creating a festive ambiance throughout the area. On arrival enjoy the orientation tour of Strasbourg. Experience the magnificent city with a Photo stop at the famous cathedral. Enjoy some leisurely free time exploring the charming Old Town.

Day 06: Today drive to the Heart of Black Forest. Visit to Lake Titisee. Scenic drive towards Switzerland. Visit Europe's biggest and most stunning site- The Rhine Falls.

After you check out, relax in your coach as we drive to the heart of Black Forest known for its picturesque woods mostly consisting of pines and firs. You will be enthralled at the scenic beauty of the quaint villages in the heart of black forest. The Black Forest region is renowned for its traditional craftsmanship, and one of its most iconic products is the cuckoo clock. Witness a demonstration of how cuckoo clocks are made. The clocks are typically made from locally sourced materials, including wood from the Black Forest. Spend some free time at Lake Titisee or for shopping. Next, sit back and relax in your coach while we drive towards scenic Switzerland. With magical views unfolding outside, we'll find ourselves in Switzerland. We will Stop at Schaffhausen where you will see the magnificent Rhine Falls - Europe's largest and most stunning. Take tons of selfies in front of this amazing natural phenomenon.

Day 07: Golden pass train experience from Zweisimmen to Gstaad. Free time at Gstaad.

Today you will have opportunity to explore Switzerland via scenic train Journey. These scenic Switzerland trains have huge panoramic windows that let you gawk at the Swiss Alps and cows grazing on vast green meadows as you jet on by. We board Golden Pass train from Zweisimmen to beautiful town called Gstaad which is an upscale resort town in the Bernese Oberland region of the Swiss Alps. Many of the famous Indian Movies have been pictured in this beautiful town. Take in the typically Swiss scenes – green pastures spotted with chalets & bell-wearing cows – surrounded by beautiful mountains. Spend some free time at Gstaad.

Day 08: Visit to Mt Titlis, Orientation tour of Lucerne with visit to Lion Monument and The Kapellbrücke (Chapel Bridge). Free time for shopping.

Today enjoy amazing scenery, a once in a lifetime experience with an exhilarating trip to the top of Mt Titlis at 3020 metres on various cable cars including Rotair, the world's first revolving cable car. Get a breathtaking unrestricted 360 degrees stunning view of the dazzling snow caped peak, deep crevasses and pristine white snow fields, dotted with massive ice boulders from every angle. Do not forget to visit the "Cliff Walk" the highest suspension bridge in Europe along the cliff of Mt.Titlis.

Later we proceed to Lucerne. famous for its wooden bridges, cobbled lanes and beautiful setting against the lake it's named after. Here we'll visit the Lion monument, a giant dying lion carved out of a wall of sandstone rock, which commemorates the Swiss Guards who were massacred in 1792 during the French Revolution. We'll also visit the Kapellbrücke - World's oldest covered wooden bridge spanning the River Reuss. Spend the evening exploring the town or some time to shop for famous Swiss watches, knives, souvenirs and chocolates.
