DAY 1 DELHI-ALMATY- WELCOMES YOU.

- Arrival in Almaty.
- Transfer Airport - Hotel by Hi - Ace.
- Check in and relax.
- Free time – can explore night Life activities at you own. Overnight at Hotel.

DAY 02 – CHARON CANYON AND KOLSAI LAKE TOUR.

□ Breakfast 07:00-10:00AM

□ The canyon formation is along the banks of the fast flowing Charyn River in a northern flow stretch of about 80 kilometers, which is a tributary of the Ile River; the river has a total length of 393 kilometers. The river rises from the Tian Shan Mountains that is spread over the arid semi-desert to the east of Almaty. In parts, it

attains a depth of 150 to 300 meters. The geological formation of the canyon is of sedimentary red sandstone which have been subject to the ‘autogenic process’ of water and wind erosion resulting in ‘weird and colorful formations’ in the form of sculptures.

□ Kolsai Lakes are a group of three picturesque alpine lakes located in the Almaty region of Kazakhstan, near

the border with Kyrgyzstan. The lakes are part of the Kolsai-Kolderi National Park, which covers an area of about 16,800 hectares. The Kolsai Lakes are renowned for their crystal-clear turquoise waters, surrounded by dense coniferous forests, meadows, and snow-capped peaks. The area is rich in biodiversity, with various

plant and animal species, including rare and endangered ones. The lakes and their surroundings offer excellent opportunities for hiking, trekking, camping, and photography. To visit Kolsai Lakes, you typically need to travel from Almaty, the largest city in Kazakhstan. The journey takes approximately 3-4 hours by

road, covering a distance of around 330 kilometers (205 miles). It is advisable to arrange transportation beforehand, either by hiring a private vehicle or joining a guided tour.

□ Free time – can explore night activities at you own. Overnight in hotel.

DAY 03 – ISSYK LAKE TOUR – KOK TOBE.

□ Breakfast 0700-1000 Hrs

□ Morning proceed towards the tour of Issyk Lake. This tour takes you to one of the most beautiful gorges of

Trans-Ili Ala-Tau, Issyk Gorge, which lies along the Kuldja tract where hundreds of years ago the trade caravans traveled. On the way you will learn a lot about the nature and history of this region and see the burial mounds of Saka period, where the famous “Golden Man” was found, which has become the state

symbol of the Republic of Kazakhstan. Then the tour route will take you to an altitude of 1756 meters above sea level, to the beautiful mountain Issyk Lake, located in the valley with the same name. The lake was formed about 10,000 years ago due to colossal landslide, resulted in the formation of the natural dam of 300

meters in height. On the lake you will enjoy the majestic beauty of its turquoise water surface and the Issyk Gorge, as well as listen to the details of the natural disaster of 1963. At the lake you will have a picnic and free time for recreation at nature.

□ Transfer back to Almaty

□ 1700 Hrs. Proceed towards Kok-Tobe. It is a mountain which is the highest point of Almaty, Kazakhstan’s largest city. There is a popular recreation area on top of the mountain. The mountain’s height is 1100 meters above sea level. Kok-Tobe is one of the main landmarks in the city, and it is popular among visitors and

tourists to Almaty. The Kok-Tobe recreational area has a variety of amusement park type attractions and restaurants. It is connected to downtown Almaty by a cable car line. The City Terminal is located near Hotel Kazakhstan. Also, there is a 372 meters tall TV Tower at the foot of the mountain. The tower can be seen from most parts of the city. Transfer to the hotel.

□ Free time – can explore night activities at you own. Overnight in hotel.

DAY 04 - ALMATY- SHYMBULAK.

□ Breakfast 07:00-10:00AM

□ Transfer to excursion at 10:30 AM

□ This tour provides you the best opportunity to see the beautiful mountain surroundings of Almaty city. The

first stop of the tour awaits you in the Meadow Gorge, where in the wonderful mountains of Trans-Ili Ala- Tau the largest high mountain skating rink in the world is located as well as the huge dam, protecting the city from destructive mudflows formed on the tops of the western Tien Shan. Next destination is Shymbulak ski

resort (Cable Car Fee Included), located at an altitude of 2230 meters above sea level. It is very popular for its mild climate, large quantity of sunny days and snow through the winter and remarkable scenery of mountain ranges.

□ Transfer to the hotel and relax.

DAY 5 – ALMATY CITY TOUR

□ Breakfast at the hotel

□ 10:30 AM - ALMATY CITY TOUR - You will know more about history and development of the southern capital of Kazakhstan and see its major attractions: Palace of President, Republic Square and Monument of Independence, and Astana Square, Panfilov Park, Abai Square and Palace of Republic, Presidential Park.

□ Continue Almaty City Tour, Rakhat Chocolate Factory shop and Local Market Zilyoni -Bazaar. You can buy Chocolates from Rakhat Chocolate Factory shop; can buy Dry Fruits at cheap rates and some souvenirs from Zilyoni Bazaar.

□ Overnight in Almaty.

DAY 06 – CHECK OUT & DEPARTURE + Arrive in Baku

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out and transfer to the Hotel.
- Transfer to the airport to board a flight to India.
- Arrival in Baku.
- Transfer to the hotel.
- Free time at the hotel

Day 7- Baku City Tour and Old City Tour

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Visit to Haydar Aliyev Center. The modern amazing structure which includes some several museums. Construction of the Center's facility was launched in 2007 and completed on May 10, 2012, to celebrate the National Leader's 89th anniversary. Recognized as one of the world's masterpieces in architecture, the Heydar Aliyev Center has immediately grown into a signature architectural landmark of modern Baku. Zaha Hadid, the author of the building's design, is a worldwide recognized architect and the winner of the prestigious Pritzker Architecture Prize.
- Visit to Carpet museum. The Azerbaijan Carpet Museum was established in 1967. It was the first specialised museum of carpets in the world. Its first exhibition was opened in 1972 in the Djuma-Mosque located in the ancient Baku Town "Icherishahar". The Museum is a treasury of Azerbaijani national culture. It demonstrated carpets in close connection with other kinds of traditional handicrafts of Azerbaijan. Its collection includes about 14 000 traditional carpets, embroideries, costumes, copper artworks, jewellery art, as well as contemporary works of glass, wood, and felt.
- Visit to Martyrs' Lane (Shehidler Khiyabany), a touching memorial to Azerbaijanis who have perished in fighting, it also provides a beautiful view of the Caspian Sea coastline and

Flame Towers.

- Walking at National Seaside Park and Little Venice
- Back to the hotel
- Visiting and survey of monumental, historical and architectural monuments of the city, including: Survey of a medieval part of city "Icheri Sheher" (Inner City)
- Visiting Maiden tower
- Visiting Shirvanshah palace
- Visiting Nizami street-the central street of Baku city
- Back to the hotel

Day 8- Gabala Tour

- Breakfast the hotel
- Departure to Gabala- Gabala is located on the territory of the Shaki-Zakatala zone, almost on the border of Dagestan and Georgia. In the vicinity of modern Gabala are the ruins of an ancient city, which is about 2000 years old

☐ On the way, you will have a stop in Shamakhi Juma Mosque that is built-in 743 which is the

most ancient known mosque in the Caucasus region.

☐ Visit Nohur Lake – a very beautiful lake. You can try horse riding and boat trip.

☐ Visit Yeddi Gozel Waterfall – One of the most beautiful waterfalls of Azerbaijan

☐ Visit Tufandagh Winter & Summer Resort – In the resort, You can try skiing, the cable car that takes you from down to the top of the mountain to see the spectacular beauty of the

mountain and city of this region.

Day 9- Atashgah and ;Yanardag Tour

☐ Breakfast the hotel

☐ Departure to Ateshgah

☐ The first stop of the tour is one of the most visited historical sights of Baku - Atashgah, also called the Temple of Fire. This sanctuary of eternal fire was built in the 17th century on the

site of the oldest temple of the Zoroastrians. For two centuries it was a place of pilgrimage for Hindus, Sikhs and other representatives of exotic Eastern cults. Ancient exhibits, located in the cells of Hindu and Zoroastrian hermits, will tell you how these ancient world religions were practiced.

☐ The next stop of the tour will be Yanardag - Burning Mountain. The eternal natural fire,

flashing from the depths of the mountain over millions of years, is a unique natural phenomenon. The fiery line surrounding the foot of the summit will give the impression of a country of lights and leave unforgettable memories of the tour.

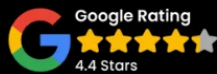
