### Travel Itinerary: -

## 1st Day (Wed 5th March): Cochin to Munnar - Arrival & Transfer

Arrival at Cochin airport/ railway station, meet and assistance. Transfer to Munnar. Munnar is 1800 mts above sea level and also the place of South India's highest peak (Anamudi - 2695 mts). On the way visit Valara, On the way, visit Valara and Cheeyappara waterfalls; both of these are seasonal attractions, along with tea plantations. On arrival at Munnar, transfer to the Hotel. Check in at Hotel. Afternoon visit Rajamala (Eravikulam National Park), the best place to see Nilgiri Tahr (Hemitragus Hilarious) - the mountain goat of South India & Tea Museum. Evening have a short visit to Munnar town. You can see the beautiful tea estates like a green paradise. Overnight at the hotel.

# 2nd Day (Thu 6th March): Munnar - Full Day Sightseeing

Morning after breakfast full day visit to Munnar. Mattupetty dam, Echo Point, Kundala Dam, Pothamedu View Point, Blossom Park etc are some of the highlights of the sightseeing. Shopping & overnight at the hotel in Munnar.

# 3rd Day (Fri 7th March): Munnar to Thekkady - Transfer & sightseeing

After breakfast checkout from the hotel and drive to Thekkady, on arrival check in to the hotel. Proceed for local Sightseeing (if time permits) else day at leisure or own activities and overnight stay at Thekkady. One of the world's most fascinating wildlife reserves. The Periyar wildlife sanctuary in Thekkady is spread across 777 sq km of which 360 sq km is thick evergreen forest. Noted for its geomorphology, diversity of wildlife and







scenic beauty, the sanctuary was declared a Tiger Reserve in 1978. Sightseeing in Thekkady: Periyar Wild Life Sanctuary, Spice Plantation.

### 4th Day (Sat 8th March): Thekkady to Alleppey - Transfer & Houseboat Stay

Check out from the resort and drive to Alleppey. Arrive at Alleppey and board the houseboat at noon for a backwater cruise and for an overnight stay. While cruising in these floating luxury- villas, let your eyes settle for the rare and the unusual - skim past Chinese fishing nets, bowed- down paddy fields, and local inhabitants engaged in making coir products, rustic homes, and ancient temples and swaying coconut groves. Overnight stay in a houseboat.

# 5th Day (Sun 9th March): Alleppey to Kovalam - Transfer & Sightseeing

After breakfast checkout from hotel / Houseboat (As per your stay) and drive to Kovalam, on arrival check in to the hotel. Proceed for local Sightseeing (if time permits) else day at leisure or own activities and overnight stay at Kovalam.Kovalam is an internationally renowned beach with three adjacent crescent beaches. It has been a favourite haunt of tourists, especially Europeans, since the 1930s. A massive rocky promontory on the beach has created a beautiful bay of calm waters ideal for sea bathing. The leisure options at this beach are plenty and diverse-sunbathing, swimming, herbal body toning massages, special cultural programmes, Catamaran cruising etc. Sightseeing:

Padmanabha Swami Temple, Kuthira Maligai Palace, Zoo, Art Gallery (All places close on Monday except Padmanabha Swami Temple).

## 6th Day (Mon 10th March): Kovalam - Kanyakumari Day Trip

After early breakfast, drive to Kanyakumari. Proceed for local sightseeing tour in the afternoon. Kanyakumari is located at the southern tip of the Indian subcontinent and represents the site where the spiritual leader Swami Vivekananda spent days in meditation upon a rock off of the coast. Padmanbhapuram Palace, Suchithram Temple, Devi Kanyakumari Temple, Vivekananda Memorial, Gandhidham and Trivenisangam are some of the sightseeing attractions in Kanyakumari. Enjoy the sunset in the evening and return to Kovalam overnight stay is arranged at kovalam.

### 7th Day (Tue 11th March): Kovalam to Trivandrum - Sightseeing & Departure

Following your hotel check-out, you will be transferred to Trivandrum for a day of sightseeing. Trivandrum, the capital of Kerala, boasts an ancient history that traces back to as early as 1000 BC. Situated between the Arabian Sea in the west and Tamil Nadu in the east, this city derives its name from Anantha Padmanabha, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu. It is adorned with numerous ancient temples, with the iconic Sree Padmanabha Swamy Temple serving as the centerpiece. The city has been thoughtfully constructed around seven low hills, with the wooded highlands of the Western Ghats on its eastern and northeastern borders, offering captivating picnic spots. A lengthy shoreline graced by internationally renowned beaches, historic landmarks, serene backwater stretches, and a vibrant cultural heritage render this district a highly sought-after tourist destination. Key attractions in Trivandrum include the Padmanabhaswamy Temple, Kuthira Maligai Palace, Zoo, and Art Gallery. (Please note that all places are closed on Mondays, except for the Padmanabhaswamy Temple.) Following your sightseeing adventure in Trivandrum, your day will conclude with a departure to the airport or railway station for your onward journey.
