Frequency asked questions for Japan trip

Check list of documents

- 1 passport
- 2 three international ticket of going and coming . And flight from Japan to
- 3 Travel policy.
- 4 hotel confirmation voucher with day wise itinerary.

Please keep one soft copy on ur mobile and extra hard copy in ur check in luggage.

- 1) local guide number.
- 2) USD only as Indian currency is not accepted and also for currency conversion. . Local currency is YEN and 80% time they prefer yen. They don't accept dollars.
- 3) daily medicine in your hand bag with valid prescription.
- 4) routine other medicine
- 5) extra pair of clothes in hand baggage
- 6) walking shoes
- 7) light jacket 2 and umbrella as weather is very unpredictable.
- 8) some eating stuff and light snacks. Please remember fruits are banned to carry in Japan.
- 9) tap water is potable for drinking.it is better to carry bottle to fill from hotel tap and for full day requirements.
- 10) bargain is very very less or not there.
- 11) as per the tourism rules we have to pay 3 usd tips per day per person in beginning of the tour and not at the end .
- 12) most important carry ready made tea/ coffee sachets which can be mixed with hot water as no creamer or milk is there in ur room in hotels .

No smoking or cooking is allowed in the room .

Carry passport on you for full day of trip as police can ask for physical verification.

Toilets are clean and free of cost .

Keep ur luggage 2 light which u can pull it in ur room.

Hand baggage is 7 kg but check in luggage varies from Air line to air line . But remember in most flights of limit is 20 kg . So ideally ur bags should not exceed 20 kg otherwise u will end up paying very High amount. Also the same rules applies for Japanese tourist buses .

Carry universal plug for charging of mobile and camera.

.caps and Google's or glares

Carry debit or credit card which is activated internationally.

It is better to carry @ 400 to 500 usd per person for any emergency as medical treatment we have to pay and claim later once we are in India.
