Tentative Itinerary: -

Day 01: - Arrival at Kathmandu and transfer to Pokhara

Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International airport Kathmandu, Fly to Pokhara approx. 25 minutes flight **Pokhara** is a place of remarkable natural beauty. The enchanting city has several beautiful lakes and offers stunning panoramic views of Himalayan peaks. The serenity of the lakes and the magnificence of the Himalaya rising behind them create the ambience that has made Pokhara such a popular place to relax and enjoy the beauty of nature. Tourism focuses on the districts of Dam-side and Lakeside (or Pardi and Baidam, in Nepali, respectively). These two areas, packed with hotels and restaurants, are a few kilometers southwest of the main Pokhara bazaar.

Overnight stay at Pokhara.

Day 02: - Pokhara sightseeing

Early morning excursion trip to Sarangkot to view sunrise over Himalaya (Subject to weather condition)

Breakfast: In hotel

From Pokhara, Sarangkot is the most popular tourist destination from where the tourist can enjoy the great view of the Pokhara valley and the magnificent view of the mountains. Sarangkot is only 5 km from Lake Side. Sarangkot is the highest view point for a sunrise and it is just 1592m high. Sarangkot is 5 degrees cooler than Pokhara.

PM: Half day sightseeing tour of Pokhara city + 01 Hour Boating at Phewa Lake

Devi's fall: Locally known as Patale Chango (Hell's fall) also known as Devin's and David's is a lovely Waterfall is about 2 km south West of Pokhara airport on the Siddhartha Highway. Legend has it that a trekker by the name of Davy was washed away by the Padi Khola and mysteriously disappeared down into an underground passage beneath the fall.

Gupteshwor Cave: Gupteshwor Gufaa, a sacred cave, lies 2 km from Pokhara airport on the Siddhartha Highway leading southwest from the city. The entrance is right across from Devi's fall and the cave is almost 3 km long. It has some big hall-size rooms and some passages where you have to crawl on all fours. This cave holds special value for Hindus since a phallic symbol of Lord Shiva is preserved here in the condition it was discovered. An entrance fee of Rs. 5 is charged and taking pictures inside the cave is prohibited.

The Old Bazaar + Bindyabasini Temple: Pokhara's traditional bazaar is colorful and so are its ethnically diverse traders. In its temples and monuments can be seen ties to the old Newar Architecture of the Kathmandu valley, located about 4 km from Lakeside, the market's original charm is still evident. This area is strewn with shops selling commodities ranging from edibles to and cloth to cosmetics and gold is a pleasant and shady spot to stroll around.

The old Bazaar is also home to one of Pokhara's most important shrines. Locally called the Bindyabasini Mandir, this white dome- like structure dominates a spacious stone – paved courtyard built atop a shady hillock. It is dedicated to Goddess Bhagwati, yet another manifestation of Shakti. The park – like grounds offers a fine picnic area, and on Saturdays, and Tuesdays when devotees flock there to offer sacrifices, it takes on a festive flavor.

Day 03: FLY POKHARA/KATHMANDU

Breakfast: In hotel

After breakfast drive back to Kathmandu which is approx. 25 minutes flight.

PM: Visit Budhanilkantha Temple

Budhanilkantha: Budhanilkantha Temple is located at the base of Shivpuri Hill within the Kathmandu valley on the northern side. It is also known as mystical Budhanilkantha temple or Narayanthan temple. Budhanilkantha literally means “Old Blue Throat”. It is only nine kilometers away from the main city. It is a deity of Lord Vishnu; Lord Vishnu is also known as Narayan. It is called Vishnu (Narayan) Jalasayan lying on Ananta Sesa, in the cosmic ocean. The deity is about thousand years old. Lord Vishnu is about five meters (Seventeen fits) long and lying in a thirteen meter (forty-three fits) long tank, as if floating with his legs crossed with his sleeping body resting on the coils of Ananta and his 11 hooded head. His four hands hold the four symbols of Vishnu, the Shankha as conch shell, and Chakra as disc, Gadha as club and Padma as lotus flower.

DAY 04: KATHMANDU

Breakfast: In hotel

AM: Half day sightseeing tour of Pashupatinath & Boudhanath.

Pashupatinath: situated approx. 4 km east of Kathmandu city, Pashupatinath temple is one of the holiest Hindu temples dedicated to Lord Shiva. Situated, amidst a lush green natural setting on the bank of the sacred Bagmati River, the temple built in pagoda style has gilded roof and richly carved silver doors. Visitors will be permitted to view the temple from the east bank of river Bagmati, entrance in the temple being strictly forbidden to all non-Hindus. Pashupatinath is the centre of annual pilgrimage on the day of Shivratri which falls in the month of February/March. Behind the temple are the cremation grounds.

Boudhanath: Situated 6 km east of Kathmandu, this colossal and ancient stupa is the epitome of Tibetan Buddhism. This 36-meter-high stupa of Boudhanath is one of the largest Stupas in South Asia enlisted as a world heritage site. It is one of the most imposing landmarks in Kathmandu that looks like a giant mandala. Beneath the watchful eyes of the Lord Buddha, it beats with life as thousands of pilgrims gather daily to make a ritual circumnavigation of the dome. It is believed that after Chinese invasion in 1959, Tibetans in thousands came to this famous Buddhist Chaitya and energized the stupa. With the chanting of monks, creaking of prayer wheels and fragrance of incense that drifts through the air, the atmosphere of Boudhanath seeks to bring inner peace and refresh our souls.

PM: Half day tour of Patan city

Patan: Located merely 5 km away from Kathmandu, Patan is the oldest city in the valley. It is one of the most historically important cities known as the center of fine arts and superb craftsmanship. It has 136 courtyards, 55 major temples and 4 Stupas set on the four-corners of the outer boundaries of this ancient city. The Patan Durbar Square has been acclaimed as one of the finest urban streetscapes in the world built around 16th to 18th centuries. The major attractions include the Royal Palace that depicts exquisite Newari architecture, Krishna Mandir with 21 shrines built entirely of stones, Golden Temple whose legends date back to 12th century and Kumbeshwar Temple which is the oldest temple in Patan. It is the “City of Beauty” that has still preserved its ancestral uniqueness and stands glorious with its culture, religion, art, and heritage.

DAY 05: DEPART KATHMANDU (B)

Breakfast at hotel

In time transfer to International airport to connect onwards flight.
