DAY 1 - WELCOME TO BAKU. PANORAMIC TOUR

- Arrival at Airport
- Transfer from Airport
- Assembly at hotel lobby in sunset time. Proceed to evening city view tour with car
- Visit to Highland Park-Alley of Martyrs, The National Assembly- also transliterated as Milli Majlis, Flame towersthe tallest skyscraper in Baku.
- Back to Hotel

DAY 2 - BAKU CITY TOUR & FLAME TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel
- Our tour program starts with Old City or Icheri Sheher is the historical core of Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan.
 The Old City is the most ancient part of Baku, which is surrounded by walls were well protected. In 2007, the Old City had a population of about 3000 people. In December 2000, the Old City of Baku, including the Palace of the Shirvanshahs' and Maiden Tower (Giz Galasi), became the first location in Azerbaijan to be classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. (walking tour)
- Tour continues with the visit to the charming example of modern architecture The Heydar Aliyev Center a 57,500 m2 building complex in Baku, Azerbaijan designed by Iraqi-British architect Zaha Hadid and noted for its distinctive architecture and flowing, curved style that eschews sharp angles. The center is named after Heydar Aliyev, the first secretary of Soviet Azerbaijan from 1969 to 1982, and president of Azerbaijan Republic from October 1993 to October 2003. (Photo shoot outside)
- Walking through Baku Boulevard which stretches along a south-facing bay on the Caspian Sea. It traditionally starts at Freedom Square continuing west to the Old City and beyond. Since 2012, the Yeni Bulvar (New Boulevard) has virtually doubled the length to 3.75 km.
- Back to Hotel

FLAMES TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel
- Tour starts with Ateshgah (Fire Worshippers Temple) Based on Persian and Indian inscriptions, the temple was
 used as a Hindu and Zoroastrian place of worship. "Atash» is the Persian word for fire. The pentagonal complex,

which has a courtyard surrounded by cells for monks and a tetra pillar-altar in the middle, was built during the 17 th and 18 th centuries.

- Trip to "Fire Mountain "- "Yanardag" —a mountain on Absheron peninsula, 25 km from north of Baku. Literally, word "Yanardag" means "Blazing mountain". Blazing bodies of flame dance on stones and floor. Yanar dag is a natural gas fire which blazes continuously on a hillside on the Absheron Peninsula on the Caspian Sea near Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan, which itself is known as the "land of fire."
- **Ganjlik Mall:** located in 10 minutes distance form city center with taxi. Ganjlik mall is the biggest Mall in Baku and contains over 80 stores, big bowling halls, the biggest movie halls, 3D cinema, Playground for children, Bravo supermarket, VIP restaurants, food courts
- Back to Hotel

DAY 3 – SHAHDAG TOUR + Departure to Georgia

- Breakfast in Hotel
- Assembly at hotel lobby. Departure to SHAHDAGH (3 hours)
- Start to use Shahdag activities. The Shahdag Mountain Resort Complex was open to the public in 2012. It is located in the Azerbaijan Greater Caucasus range, the site is located near Shahdag National Park, which is known for having an intact ecological system and an untouched flora and fauna. It is the first and largest ski resort in Azerbaijan. Plans for the project include 4-5-star hotels, golf-clubs, 160-180
- Departure transfer to Airport
- Flight to Tbilisi

DAY 4 ARRIVAL TBILISI + TBILISI CITY TOUR

- Pick up from the Airport, transfer to Hotel
- Check-in, Overnight stay
- Breakfast in Hotel
- Go for Tbilisi City Tour. Start with the world largest orthodox Holy Trinity cathedral, Continue to Metekhi church and monument to Vakhtang Gorgasali, the legendary founder of Tbilisi. Walk down to the district of Sulfur bath houses passing by the only mosque in Tbilisi. Stroll through the
- Sharden area full of narrow streets with cozy cafés, wine tasting bars, souvenir shops, and breathe in the living past.
- Visit Sioni Cathedral, Anchiskhati basilica and the clock tower of famous Rezo Gabriadze Theatre. Cross the Bridge of Peace to Rike Park. There we will take Cable car to Narikala Fortress. The best place to release adrenaline, dopamine, oxytocin, serotonin, endorphins and just feel happy. Charge with emotions and unforgettable memories.
- Overnight in Tbilisi

DAY 5 Gudauri – Mtskheta – Borjomi

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Departure towards Borjomi
- Visit Mtskheta (former capital of Georgia)
- City tour in Mtskheta: Jvari Monastery (6th century)
- Arrive in Borjomi: Famous for geothermal spring mineral water
- Visit Borjomi Park
- Return to hotel
- Overnight stay in Borjomi







DAY 6 Tbilisi- Ananuri- Gudauri- Tbilisi

- You will meet the Driver and Guide in your hotel lobby, the route will take over the Georgian Military Highway up North, towards the border with Russia.
- You will reach Jhinvali Water reservoir created during the soviet era. You will spend 20 minutes there and promptly continuing your way to Ananuri complex, a former residence of Argveti Dukes.
- You will reach Ananuri complex. The complex features churches and towers dating back to the 16-17th
 centuries, beautifully overlooking the Jhinvali reservoir. Because of local uprising and clashes Ananuri was
 controlled by different Dukes. In the complex you will see two churches from 17th century. The older one was
 built in 1689 and has sophisticated ornaments of grapes and crosses symbolizing soul of Georgian culture. You
 will spend about 40 minutes there.
- Continue your drive to see the conjunction of two small mountain rivers famous for the fact that being different in color they still keep their own colors even after merge. Continuing on the way you will have a chance to taste the mineral mountain springs in Mleta.
- You will reach Gudauri and spend about 2-3 hours there. We will drive over the Cross Pass and make a short stop at the Soviet-era "People's Friendship" mountain view point overlooking a deep gorge of Caucasus mountain range. There you will have lunch break and free time for activities
- Transfer to Tbilisi
- End of the tour

DAY 7 Georgia & Armenia border + Yerevan City tour - Vernissage

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- This ancient site is a historical-archeological museum-reserve with a surface of 60 hectares.
- Continue Yerevan City tour Yerevan sightseeing, including City center, Republic square, City panorama, Mother Armenia Monument, Parliament, President's Residence, Opera House. Visit the Armenian Genocide Memorial Complex.
- Visit to Cascade complex, which is considered the modern art center of Yerevan, with art pieces displayed throughout the whole area: the boulevard and up the stairs, from top of which you can enjoy the panoramic view on the city and Mountain Ararat. Cascade is home to Cafes Jian modern art museum. Visit Vernissage open air market of handicrafts.

DAY 8 Dilijan – Lake Sevna – Sevanavnk – Tsaghkadzor - Yerevan

- Transfer to border of Georgia & Armenia.
- Pick up from the border of Georgia & Armenia.
- On the way we will visit Dilijan resort town which is known as "Armenian Switzerland".
- Then drive to Sevan Lake, which is the largest body of water in Armenia and Caucasus region, then visit Sevanavank monastery located on the peak of Sevan peninsula.
- Then drive to Tsaghkadzor (means "gorge of flowers") town, the magical place of forested mountains. Opportunity to go up to the mountain peaks by rope way, where you will catch an unforgettable gorgeous panoramic view of this part of the world (going up the first level and back) from Teghenis Mountain. In winter Tsaghkadzor is a well-known ski resort with several levels of ropeways leading up the mountains. In summer it's a pleasant place to spend the afternoon in nature and enjoy the sun. Drive to Yerevan.

Day 9: Departure

- Transfer to the airport
- Breakfast at the hotel. Check out.
