Day 01: Arrival at Delhi Airport Transfer to Delhi Hotel – Overnight stay at Delhi Hotel

Day 02: After Breakfast Explore the iconic Red Fort (Lal Qila), a UNESCO World Heritage Site and former residence of Mughal emperors. Visit the magnificent Jama Masjid, one of India's largest mosques. Immerse yourself in the vibrant Chandni Chowk market, known for its street food, spices, textiles, and jewelry. Enjoy a traditional rickshaw ride through the narrow lanes of Old Delhi. Head back to your hotel for a rest or explore Connaught Place for dinner and shopping. Overnight stay at Delhi Hotel.

Day 03: After Breakfast Visit the Lotus Temple, a Bahá'í House of Worship known for its unique lotus-shaped design. Visit India Gate, a war memorial arch, and take a stroll around the surrounding area. Explore the grand Swaminarayan Akshardham Temple, a Hindu temple complex known for its intricate carvings and exhibitions. Visit the National Museum to explore India's rich history and art. Overnight stay at Delhi Hotel.

Day 04: Transfer to Delhi Hotel – Jaipur Hotel via Car (5 hr 24 min (306.6 km)

After Breakfast Check out to the Delhi hotel and proceed direct Jaipur Hotel-Check in the hotel. Overnights stay at Jaipur Hotel.

Day 05: After breakfast move your foot ahead to enjoy Local Sightseeing of Jaipur. Visit Amber Fort, Jaigarh Fort, Jantar Mantar, City Palace, Jal Mahal and Hawa Mahal (Photo Shoot). Evening enjoy Local Market. Overnight Stay at Jaipur Hotel.

Day 06: After breakfast visit Chand Baori a stepwell built over a thousand years ago in the Abhaneri village of Rajasthan. It is one of the largest stepwells in the

world and also one of the most beautiful ones. Later proceed to Bhangad fort. It is known for its serene atmosphere, picturesque Aravalli Mountains and the architectural marvel. Evening is free for shopping for colorful clothes at the Bappu market or jewelry at the Johari Bazar. Overnight in Jaipur.

Day 07: Transfer to Jaipur Hotel – Jodhpur Hotel via car (5 hr 36 min (334.3 km)

After Breakfast Check out to the Jaipur hotel and proceed direct Jodhpur Hotel-Check in the hotel. Overnights stay at Jodhpur Hotel.

Day 08: Begin your exploration with Mehrangarh Fort, one of the largest forts in India, exploring its palaces, courtyards, and museums. Visit Jaswant Thada, a beautiful white marble memorial near the fort, offering stunning views. Explore the vibrant Sardar Market and Clock Tower, followed by dinner at a rooftop restaurant with views of the illuminated fort. Overnight Stay at Jodhpur Hotel.

Day 09: Transfer to Jodhpur – Agra Hotel Via car (9h 35m (572 km)

After Breakfast Check out to the Jodhpur hotel and proceed direct Agra Hotel-Check in the hotel. Overnights stay at Agra Hotel.

Day 10: Magnificent Taj Mahal Agra. This morning we enjoy a memorable visit to the Taj Mahal at sunrise. Described as the most extravagant monument ever built for love, this fine example of Mughal architecture was built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved second wife-Mumtaz Mahal, who died tragically during childbirth. Built entirely of white marble, construction began in 1631, the year in which Mumtaz died and was not completed until 1653. A staggering total of 20,000 workers contributed their skills in the construction of this unique mausoleum. After exploring the legendary Taj Mahal, we drive to the deserted city of Fatehpur Sikri. The deserted Mughal city of Fatehpur Sikri was built by Emperor Akbar in 1569 and abandoned after fifteen years due to scarcity of water. The attractions in Fatehpur Sikri are Jama Masjid – a beautiful building containing elements of Persian and Hindu design. The main entrance is through a 54-metre high Buland Darwaza, the Gate of Victory, constructed to commemorate Akbar's victory in Gujarat.

Day 11: We head to Agra Fort for a short visit. Behind its colossal walls are some of the finest Mughal buildings in India. Construction of the fort commenced during the reign of Emperor Akbar and additions continued to be made until the rule of his grandson Shah Jahan. During Akbar's time, it was primarily a military fort though later the focus shifted and it partially became a palace. After our touring you'll have time to relax back at the hotel.

Day 12: Departure from Agra Hotel – Agra Railway Station.
