Tentative travel itinerary: -

Day 01: Rishikesh- Guptkashi (180 km / 6- 7 hours)

Meet our driver at Rishikesh and drive to Guptkashi via Moolgarh Lambgoan. On the way you can see the beautiful river Mandakini at Tilwara. The Mandakini River comes from Kedarnath, drive alongside the river to reach Guptakashi, visit ArdhNarishwar Temple in Guptakashi. Afterwards smooth transfer to the hotel and overnight stay at Guptkaashi Hotel.

Guptakashi: The name GuptKashi means "Hidden Banaras". Mythology describes how the Pandavabrothers were searching for a glimpse of Shiva. Shivji first concealed himself at Guptkashi, but after that he walked up to Kedarnath valley, where the Pandava wish got fulfilled. Kedarnath is identified for its ancient Vishwanath Temple devoted to the lord Shiva, which is equivalent to the temple situated in Varanasi (Kashi). The other well-known temple here is Ardhanareshvara Temple, a half man half woman forms of Shiva and Parvati.

Guptkashi Weather - Pleasant in summer, the temperature ranges from 25-30 degree Celsius. Cold in winters.

Day 02: Guptkashi -Kedarnath (30 km + 16 km trek)

This morning post breakfast, visit to kedarnath. After darshan of Kedarnath Temple, overnight stay at Kedarnath which will fill your mind and thoughts with purity.

By Helicopter: For visit to Kedarnath via Helicopter our driver will transfer you your pre-book Helipad in the morning. For this visit, the flight will be of 5 to 10 minutes (one way). After that our car will dropyou at Hotel for rest.

By Trek: Our driver will drop you at Sonprayag in the morning then you have to take local jeep for Gourikund and then your trek starts for kedarnathji. After darshan you follow the same and return back to Sonprayag. There is big parking issue so driver will be back at any other place if his contact no.is not working then you have to arrange other taxi or wait for your driver and send the massage to any other driver.

Kedarnath: The Kedarnath shrine, one of the 12 jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva, is a beautiful spot situated. There is a strong mythological fellow feeling to Kedarnath. Legend has it that the Pandavas after fighting their own brothers in the Kurukshetra war were feeling guilty and asked for forgiveness from Lord Shiva. But Shiva repeatedly eluded them and found refuge in Kedarnath in the form of a bull. Onbeing followed he dived into the ground, leaving his hump on the surface. The remaining portions ofLord Shiva appeared at four other places and are worshipped there as his manifestations. The arms appeared at Tungnath, the face at Rudranath, the belly at Madhmaheshwar and his locks (hair) with head at Kalpeshwar. Kedarnath and the four above-mentioned shrines are treated as PanchKedar.







Another interesting fact about Kedarnath is that the temple, built in the 8th century A.D by Guru AdiSankaracharya, stands adjacent to the temple built by the Pandavas.

Kedarnath Weather - Due to its high altitude the weather in Kedarnath remains cold for most part of the year. Summer here is cool and pleasant while winter is severe. During summer season the temperature varies around 20°Celsius. Light woolen wear is recommended. Winter season in Kedarnath is severe with mercury falling to as low as 0°Celsius. During this time the place experiences snowfall as well. Due to the extreme climatic conditions, this time is usually avoided by tourists.

Day 03: Kedarnath -Guptkashi (16 km trek + 30 Kms)

Morning, have a breakfast. Then we will return to Guptkashi so that we can easily visit Badrinath next day. After reaching Guptkashi, check in at hotel. Overnight halt at Guptkashi.

This return journey will be either by helicopter or trek (as per your choice).

Day 04: Guptkashi -Badrinath (200 km / 8-9 hours)

On this fresh morning after breakfast, drive to Badrinath. On arrival atBadrinath, our representative will help you for smooth transfer to the hotel. Pilgrims after having a bath in the Taptkund go for the Darshan of Badrivishal and Aarti in evening. Brahamakapal is significant for PinddanShraddh of ancestors (Pitras). There are other interesting sightseeing spots like Mana, VyasGufa, Maatamoorti, Charanpaduka, Bhimkund and the "Mukh" of the Saraswati River. Just within the three kms of Badrinathjee. Overnight stay at Badrinath.

Badrinath one of the 'Ancient Four Dhams' and also one of the most celebrated pilgrimage spots of the country and is situated at an elevation of 3,133 meters, guarded on either side by the two mountains ranges known as Nar & Narayan with the towering Neelkanth Peak providing a splendid backdrop. This revered spot was once carpeted with wild berries. Thus, the place got the name "Badri van", meaning "forest of berries".

TaptKund: Natural thermal springs on the bank of the river Alaknanda, where it is customary to bath before entering the Badrinath temple.

Mana Village: Inhabited by an Indo-Mongolian tribe, it is the last Indian village before Tibet.

Vasundhara: As the name suggests, vasundhara is a magnificent water fall. This place is 5 km from Badrinath out of which 2 km is motor able up to Mana.

BhimPul: On the other side of Mana village, a massive rock forming a natural bridge, lies over the roaring Saraswati River. It presents a spectacular view of water thundering down through the narrow passage under the rock and is believed to have been placed there by Bhim, the second eldest among the five Pandava brothers.

VyasGufa (cave): Near Mana Village, this is a rock-cave where VedVyas is believed to have composed the Mahabharata and the pauranic commentaries.

Badrinath Weather: The average maximum temperature will be around 18° Celsius and the average minimum is 8° Celsius. Warm and woolen clothes are hence required for a stay in Badrinath throughout the year. Winter in Badrinath is often accompanied by snow falls. Winter is very chilly with an average temperature of 5° Celsius. Due to the extreme climatic conditions, this time is usually closed for tourists.

Day 05: Badrinath -Rudraprayag via Joshimath (165 km / 5-6 hours)

This day morning will start with breakfast and afterwards move forward for Rudraprayag via Joshimath. On the way, visit Narsingh Temple at Joshimath further drive for Rudraprayag. On the arrival at Rudraprayag, check into the hotel.







Overnight stay at Rudraprayag hotel.

Joshimath is situated on the slopes above the confluence of the rivers Alaknanda and Dhauliganga. One of the four 'Maths' established by Adi Shankaracharya. Joshimath is the winter seat of Badrinath. The idol is brought down to Joshimath and installed in the temple for people to worship. There are many other temples in the township. The most important is the temple of Narsingh with the idol of Lord Vishnu. The left arm of this deity is getting destroyed with time and the popular belief holds that the day the arm completely withers Badrinath valley will cease to exist and the Gods will transfer the residence into the neighboring Niti Valley at BhavishyaBadri.

Rudraprayag is one of the PanchPrayag (five confluences) of Alaknanda River. It is confluence of rivers Alaknanda and Mandakini. Kedarnath, a Hindu holy town is located 86 km from Rudraprayag.

Rudraprayag Weather - Generally hot in summer, the temperature ranges from 35-40 degree Celsius, winter: The Days are pleasantly cool but the nights are cold, temperature ranges from 20o C to 05o C.

Day 06: Rudraprayag – Rishikesh (137 km / 3-4 hours)

On this last day morning after breakfast, drive back for Haridwar via Rishikesh. At Rishikesh visit Janaki setu, ramjhula. Tour ends here.

Rishikesh: Rishikesh 'place of sages' is a celebrated spiritual town on the bank of Ganga and is surrounded by Shivalik range of the Himalayas on three sides. It is said that when Raibhya Rishi did hard penances, God appeared by the name of "Hrishikesh" and this area hence firth came to be known as Rishikesh. Named after the Lord Vishnu, Rishikesh is a holy city for Hindus. Located in the foothills of theHimalaya in northern India it is also known as the yoga center of the world and is home to many worldrenowned ashrams. Rishikesh styles itself as the 'Yoga Capital of the World', with masses of ashrams and all kinds of yoga and meditation classes. The fast-flowing Ganges is surrounded by forested hills inside the city. Apart from temples and ashrams Rishikesh is now a popular white-water rafting centre, backpacker hang-out, and gateway to treks in the Himalaya.
