## REASONS FOR REFUSAL

You have applied for a visa to visit the UK.

In deciding whether you meet the requirements of Appendix V: Visitor of the Immigration Rules (<https://www.gov.uk/guidance/immigration-rules/immigration-rules-appendix-v-visitor>), I have considered:

- your application and any additional relevant information you have provided with it
- your immigration history

### The decision

• I have refused your application for a visit visa because I am not satisfied that you meet the requirements of paragraph(s) V4.2, and V4.3 of Appendix V of the Immigration Rules because

- You have applied for a visa to travel to the UK for 12 days with your spouse.
- In considering your application, I have to consider whether you intend to leave the United Kingdom at the end of your visit. As part of this, I have to consider the information provided by you about your personal and economic circumstances.
- You have declared that you wish to travel to the UK for a period of 12 days. You have applied with your spouse. You state that you are unemployed and that your spouse will fully fund your proposed visit to the UK. However, your spouse has been refused a visit visa for the UK on this occasion and it is unclear from your application whether their funding will remain available to you were you to travel without them. Therefore, I am not satisfied that the purpose of your visit remains and that adequate funding will be available to you.
- Given the above I am not satisfied that you are a genuine visitor and will leave the UK at the end of your visit or that you have sufficient funds available to cover your costs whilst in the UK without working or accessing public funds.

## NEXT STEPS

In relation to this decision, there is no right of appeal or right to administrative review.
